KC Scholars offers three college scholarship programs:

- **College Savings Match** (up to \$1,400) application is only available to 9th graders.
- **Traditional** (up to \$50,000) application is only available to 11th graders.
- **Adult Learners** (up to \$50,000) application is only available to adults 18 years and older with a high school diploma or equivalent.

All scholarship programs have a competitive application process. All applicants must reside in or attend high school in one of the following 6 counties - (Kansas: Johnson and Wyandotte Counties; Missouri: Cass, Clay, Jackson, and Platte Counties).

Schedule of College Planning Events

Throughout the year, KC Scholars plans and hosts college preparation and planning events, such as college fairs, financial aid workshops, parent engagement events, and more. We also promote other events planned and hosted in the community that are focused on college planning and career exploration.

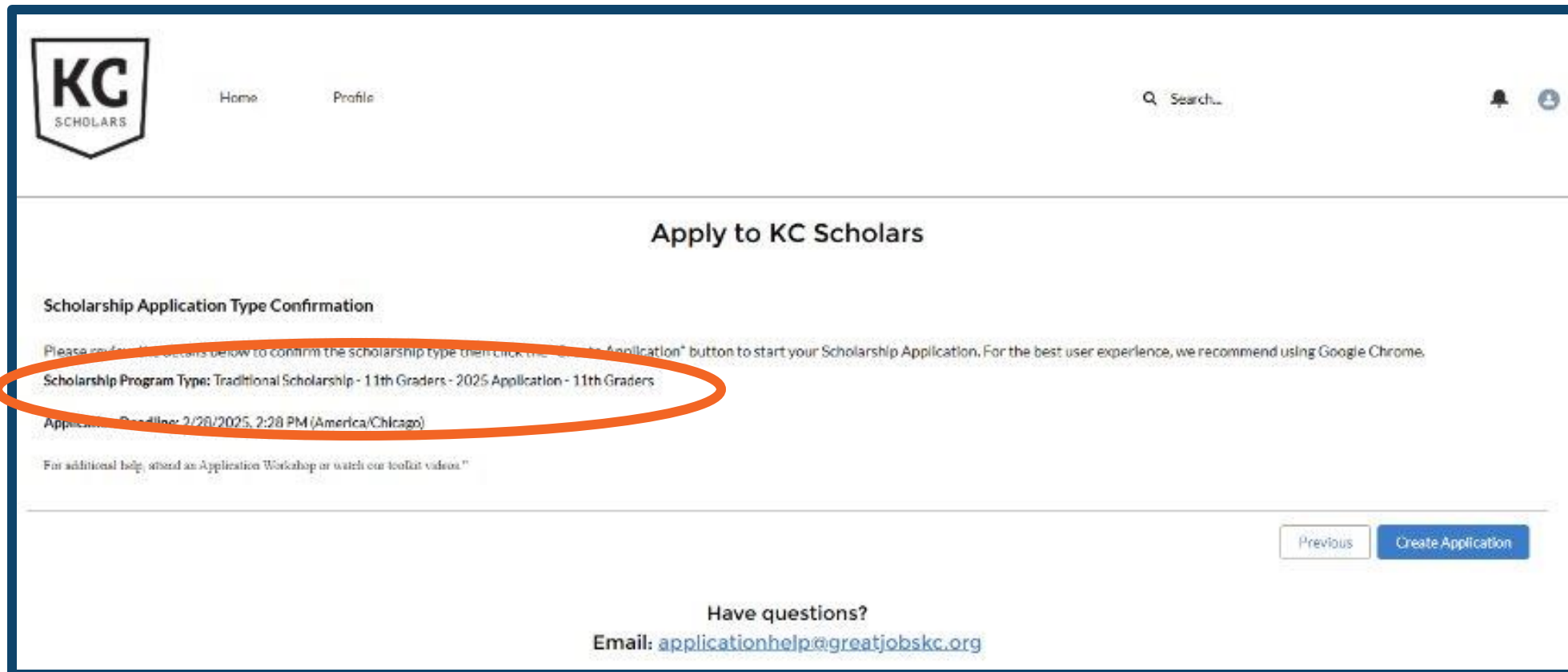

For each personal statement, the response must be a minimum of 250 words and a maximum of 750 words. Personal statements must also be written in English to aid in the Community Review process. The purpose of a personal statement is to learn about you. Your personal statements will be scored by Community Reviewers based on a rubric. Community Reviewers would like to hear your true voice; we discourage the use of AI.

KC Scholars will not return any information submitted for this application process including your response to the personal statements. We suggest you save a copy of your responses if you plan to use them in the future. Please read over essay prior to submitting.

- **Clear Structure:** Check that your personal statements are well-organized, with a logical flow from one idea to the next.
- **Depth of Reflection:** Ensure your personal statements include thoughtful reflection on your experiences and growth.
- **Specific Examples:** Use concrete examples to illustrate your points rather than general statements.
- **Link to Future Goals:** Clearly connect your experiences or passions to your personal and career goals.
